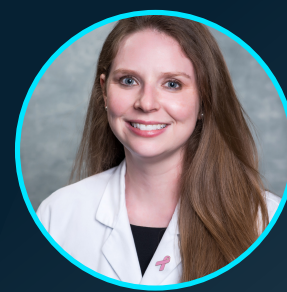
2024 PENMAN MEMORIAL LECTURER, MICHAEL JENKINS
